# Voting Notice and Instructions



## Northwest Airlines Council 90 - ATL Officer Election

July 1, 2009

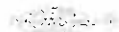
*Dear AFA-CWA Member:*

Your council has recently completed nominating candidates for local council President, Vice President, Secretary. You will be voting to elect these officers via a telephone or Internet balloting system as provided under the AFA Constitution and Bylaws. The term of office ends on June 30, 2011.

All active (meaning dues paying) Members in Good Standing on the count date who have cast their ballot will have their vote counted. Members who are on a leave of absence or voluntary furlough beyond 90 days must continue to pay dues beyond their leave obligation (3 months) in order to remain active with the union and be eligible to vote. You must pay any outstanding dues before the count date or your vote will not be counted. Approval by a simple majority of valid ballots cast by members.

To vote, follow the instructions on the back of this page. You may vote as many times as you like, using either the telephone or Internet. Only your last recorded vote will be counted in the election tally. If you have any questions, please contact Membership Services.

## ***Voting Instructions***

1. If you have your VIN (voter ID number) and PIN (personal ID number), skip to Step 2. Otherwise:  
Call **1-877-AFA-VOTE (1-877-232-8683)** from within the United States or Canada.  
When requested, enter the Activation Code shown on the front of this page.  
Write down the VIN (voter ID number) spoken to you.  
Enter a PIN (personal ID number) of your choice, *and confirm*. Write down the PIN with your VIN.  
Your VIN and PIN are *permanent* voting credentials. *Save them* for all future AFA-CWA elections.  
If you don't want to immediately vote by phone, hang up and skip to Step 2.  
Follow the prompts to vote. Done!
2. To vote by *Internet*:  
Go to: <http://www.afanet.org/elections> and click the link under *Click Here to Vote*.  
To vote by *telephone*:  
Call **1-877-AFA-VOTE (1-877-232-8683)** from within the United States or Canada.
3. Enter your VIN and PIN, and follow the directions for voting. Done!

## ***What Is a Vote Confirmation Number?***

*The voting system provides you a "vote confirmation number" after you cast your vote.  
Save this number and you can review your vote later, by either phone or Internet.*

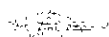
## ***Ensure the Secrecy of Your Vote***

*Do not share your VIN, PIN, or vote confirmation number with anyone, including election officials.*

## ***Save Time in Future Elections***

*Store your VIN and PIN in a safe and accessible place. If you do, you can proceed directly to Step 2 of voting.*

**INSTRUCTIONS for WRITE-INS** To cast a vote for a write-in candidate, you must enter your write-in candidate's AFA Member Number through the telephone keypad or enter it on the Internet screen where indicated. The AFA Member Number is an 8-digit number composed of your carrier's AFA 2-digit code (43=Northwest Airlines) followed by the employee ID number. If the ID is less than 6 digits in length, add leading zeroes. As an example: if the NWA employee ID is 12345, the AFA Member Number is 43012345; if the NWA employee number is 123456, the AFA Member Number is 43123456. (Carrier Number of 43+NWA ID Number.)
