AFA-CWA's FlightPAC – Strengthening the Flight Attendant Voice in Congress

For flight attendants to be heard in Congress ... you don't have to live in Washington, D.C.

We work in one of the most heavily regulated professions in the United States. So many of the issues that impact the condition of our workplace, what our jobs look like, our responsibilities and almost every aspect of our job is impacted by decisions made by the Federal Aviation Administration (a federal agency) and

in the Halls of Congress. Because of that, it is so important that AFA-CWA members have a strong and loud voice when it comes to influencing Congress. For decades, AFA-CWA members have been cultivating relationships with Representatives and Senators, Democrat and Republican, to influence Congress to act to improve our lives and working conditions.



Since 1982, we have pooled our voluntary contributions through FlightPAC, the AFA-CWA Political Action Committee (PAC), to support our lobbying efforts and help elect members to the US House and Senate who will stand up for our issues. Through FlightPAC, AFA-CWA members can combine small monthly contributions in support of legislators interested in improving our profession.



When we as flight attendants can't all make it to Washington, DC to talk directly with members of Congress about the issues that affect us on the job, we can rely on FlightPAC to speak for us on issues like mandating meaningful rest periods, improving cabin air quality, getting work place safety and health protections and updating our security train-

ing. Congress has the power to change these things but only if the candidates that support flight attendants are elected and re-elected to Congress. FlightPAC gives us the ability to elect the candidates that support flight attendants and our goals.

In these difficult and uncertain times, it's more important than ever that we have a strong and powerful voice in Washington, DC. We must stand together to protect ourselves and our flying partners. Please join us in supporting FlightPAC today.



Legislate, Not Negotiate

AFA-CWA's goal is the enactment of legislation on issues affecting our jobs and workplace so we are not forced to address them at the bargaining table with our employers. This allows us to focus bargaining on improvements in wages and benefits. FlightPAC is a critically important tool to get us to that goal.

Victories on Capitol Hill Due to AFA-CWA's Political and Legislative and Political Activism and Leadership

- ✓ Smoking ban on all domestic flights
- ✓ Increased penalties for assaulting flight attendants onboard the aircraft
- ✓ Flight attendant certification, as with pilots and mechanics, to perform duties
- ✓ Seniority protections in airline mergers, i.e. no more being stapled to the bottom of the seniority list like what happened to the former TWA flight attendants

Current Legislative Goals

- **Flight Attendant Fatigue:** Extreme fatigue experienced by our members is a serious safety risk. AFA-CWA is working to improve regulations governing flight attendant rest periods.
- **Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA):** The unique nature of flight attendant work schedules does not qualify most of us for family medical leave under current FMLA. AFA-CWA is diligently working to enact changes in law to clarify that full time flight attendants have the same family medical leave rights as other workers.
- **Carry-on Bag Limitations:** Excessive and overweight carry-on baggage poses safety and security risks. AFA-CWA is working to enact enforceable and meaningful limits.
- **Cabin Air Quality:** While we have succeed in securing funding for several cabin air quality studies, AFA-CWA remains committed to addressing this serious health and safety risk.

My contribution to FlightPAC is not tax deductible. As an AFA-CWA member, I am entitled to make voluntary contributions to FlightPAC at any time. Gifts or donations to FlightPAC are not a condition of membership in AFA-CWA. Payroll authorizations shall remain in full force until revoked by me, pursuant to the provisions of the agreement between my airline and the Association of Flight Attendants-CWA. Federal law forbids AFA-CWA from accepting FlightPAC contributions from foreign nationals who are not U.S. citizens and have not been legally admitted to the United States for permanent residence.
